



Anna Rondeau Memorial Scholarship



Anna Rondeau, at the tender age of 12, tragically left this world in March of 2018.

Anna was a passionate and talented swimmer who was an enthusiastic and inclusive member of the Regina Optimist Dolphins Swim Team. Anna loved the pool and her teammates.

Each year, the RODS raise money for the Anna Rondeau Memorial Scholarship in memory of our teammate. Your donation in her memory will provide financial assistance so that more children can participate in the sport of swimming that Anna loved. Anna had Olympic dreams; this scholarship will assist new and current athletes to pursue their own dreams.

To date, this scholarship has raised over \$19,000 dollars and has helped families struggling financially to keep their swimmers in the pool. On average, 5 RODS families each year receive financial assistance from this scholarship.



The \$50 entry fee will cover the cost of the entries for official events, an Anna swim cap and a meal following catered by Wallnuts Catering.

Officials are required and job sign up will be available soon. Parents who have not taken the Stroke and Turn course should sign up for the in-person clinic next Saturday.




