Winter Classic

The 2024 Winter Classic was a great meet, with 65 RODS participating! This is the first Long Course meet of the season, which for our senior swimmers means the first opportunity to post qualifying times for National meets like Westerns, Nationals, and Olympic Trials. For every swimmer, it's a great chance to try something new and swim in an Olympic-length pool (some for the first time!).

The RODS had 26 swimmers that finished in the Top 3 in their age group.

Standards

Congratulations to **Jazz Kotia** for getting her ManSask AA time with a 35.45 LC 50m Freestyle! That beats her short course time of 36.05 set at the RODS Winter Solstice in December.

Races

Without a doubt, one of the best races of the weekend was the epic showdown between Prospect's **Neven Le** and Daniel Fang from Flatland in the 200m Freestyle. Neven made a valiant charge



on the final 50, splitting 38, 44, 46, and a blistering 41 to make it a super close race - less than a quarter of a second! Neven also dropped almost 13 full seconds off of his previous time of 3:03.51.

The biggest percent improvement came from **Natalie Pelzer**, who improved from 1:52.56 to a 1:27.58 in her 100m Backstroke! Great job Natalie. Honourable mention goes to **Santiago Lam**, who had second-most improvement with his 50m Backstroke dropping from 1:06.67 to a 52.32. Great effort leads to great improvement and eventually great results!

Finally, another awesome swim was an amazing 50 Fly by **Taylah Fisher**, slicing almost 2 and a half seconds off of her previous best time to rank 3rd in the country so far this season for 11 year olds! Great job everyone on their amazing effort this weekend.
