Fundraising

If you haven't handed in your raffle tickets and cash yet, make sure you bring them by the raffle table at the swim meet this weekend. The draw will be made at noon on Sunday.

1. Rider Games

Sign up to run a cash register and sell beer at the section 28 bar at Mosaic Stadium. People who sign up for this event must be at least 19 years of age and must complete the Special Occasion Responsible Service of Alcohol online course which is required in Saskatchewan for all people who serve alcohol. Go to stec.skillbuilder.co to access the online course. Normally, the site will charge \$30 to take the course, but if you type in the code VOLUNTEER, you won't be charged anything. Print a copy of the certificate as soon as you complete the course and keep it on your phone in case you get asked to show your validation. Email a copy

to scott adelman@hotmail.com. The certificate is good for 4 years.

Typically, we work 2.5 hours before kick-off and 2.5 hours after kickoff. Workers are paid at the end of the football season. Each game pays approximately \$85 plus tips. Tip money will be divided and distributed differently this year. The Dolphins will receive a cheque at the end of the season for all tip money earned throughout the season. Tip money will be divided evenly amongst all workers regardless of which particular games they worked. The total amount of tips will be divided by the total amount of shifts worked throughout the season by our club, in order to calculate the amount earned per shift. Tips will then be deposited into your swim accounts. Families are only allowed to sign up for a total of 4 shifts to start with, and each family can also sign up as a substitute for 2 shifts. This will ensure that everyone has had the opportunity to sign up for Rider games and earn fundraising credits to their swim accounts. If there are any positions left vacant after the sign-up deadline, members will be allowed to sign up for additional shifts, including the substitute positions as well. The Rider Game Coordinator may sign up for additional shifts initially, to ensure that there is consistency and accuracy at the work site. All complaints and distribution of communication are handled by the Rider Game Coordinator. Contact Scott Adelman, our Rider Game Coordinator,

Rider Games will be available for sign-up soon. Members will receive an email inviting them to sign up for 4 shifts plus 2 additional substitute shifts. Members are required to complete and obtain a valid Special Occasion Responsible Service of Alcohol Certificate.

2. June & July Bingos at Fantasyland Bingo
