Re: Wascana Pool Test Leisure Swim

The City of Regina is excited to be opening the New Wascana Pool this summer and the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services team has been working hard all year in preparation for a successful opening. As part of a safe, successful opening, lifeguards will be participating in on site orientation and training to the new pool followed by several controlled test leisure swims.

Aquatic user groups and members of their household are invited to participate in the first test leisure swim on **Wednesday**, **May 31**st **from 5 to 8 p.m.** User groups have been selected as the first group because we know there will generally be a high degree of swimming ability. We ask that all people in attendance have strong swimming ability. We understand this may mean some of your family members may not be able to participate, however be aware this is for safety reasons so we appreciate your cooperation in honouring this request. General City of Regina supervision guidelines still apply: any individual 7 years of age and under must be within an arm's reach of an adult.

This swim is pre-registration only with limited capacity. To register, please log online to your Regina Recreation Online customer account. The direct link to the activity is here, or search for activity number 69576. Each individual attending the swim needs to register. Registration will open on May 27th at 7 a.m. and is on a first come, first serve basis. There is no cost for this swim. Please do not share this activity number with the general public; at least one member of your party must be a registered member of a user group. Club membership may be confirmed.

During the swim, you will have access to amenities including water slides, lazy river, spray features, diving boards, and climbing wall. Lifeguards may open and close the amenities throughout the test swim to meet the training needs of the swim. There will be a simulated emergency during the test swim, and you may be asked to leave the pool for the duration of the simulated emergency.

Wascana Pool is located at 2400 Wascana Drive. Parking will be available in University of Regina lot 20. Vehicles must be registered at the parking kiosk located inside the Wascana Pool change building. Please see the cashier for the parking coupon code.

You will receive a link to a survey after the swim to provide feedback on your experience so we can provide the best experience possible on opening day. Thanks for your help!
