



Would you attend more or less meets if we no longer provided team travel? ³⁶ responses




For a self travel meet, would you consider taking another swimmer(s) with you whose parents were unable to travel? 36 responses




For a self travel meet, would you consider sending your swimmer with another RODS family if you were unable to travel?
